Information Update:

The following represents information regarding the 2008/2009 CSRA Snowcross race series.

NEW 2009 ISR RULE CHANGES:

1. – All Super Stock 600 classes, 2007 and previous Stock 440cc models are now allowed to compete in all Super Stock 600 classes.

2. - Junior-1, Junior-2, and Junior Girls, classes will remain the same as last winter. Racer's and will be required to compete with 440cc race sleds during the 2009 race season.

NEW CSRA "JUNIOR F1" CLASS:

CSRA will introduce a new Junior class called (Junior F1) This class is being introduced as a transition class that will make it safer for **new** Junior racers or Novice class racers to move into the Junior division. The "Junior F1" class will be designated for racers aged (13-17yrs). Racers must compete with a 499cc - 600cc Fan cooled or 4-Stroke, Stock snowmobile. Studs are not permitted in this class.

Note: Experienced Junior racers that have had a 1st place finish in Junior 1 or Junior 2 will not be permitted to race in this class.

August 23, 2008 – Sno-Motion Summer Snocross, Greenville Michigan

CSRA – Sport, Semi-Pro and Pro racers are invited to race at a one day Summer Snocross Race at Nielsen's Speed Shop in Greenville Michigan. The race course will be a wood chip base with snow on top. The snow has been saved and stored from last winter. Entries are limited to (18) per class. All entries must be submitted by August 10.
