CSRA / ISR Information Update:

NEW 2009 /2010 CLASS AND RULE CHANGES

JUNIOR-1, JUNIOR-2, JUNIOR GIRLS RACING

Junior-1, Junior-2, and Junior Girls, classes will now be permitted to use the new 2009 or 2010 (limited build) 600cc race sleds with throttle limiters.

The performance of the new 600cc race sleds with throttle limiters is similar to a older 440cc racer. Throttle limiters will be available for Junior racers by each manufacture. Specifications for the throttle limiters will be provided by ISR for tech inspection to ensure the performance of all brands are similar. Junior-1, Junior-2 and Junior Girls may also compete with the older 440cc race sleds without throttle limiters. Racers may also compete with any 0–600cc Stock production snowmobiles including the new Arctic Cat Sno Pro 500 without throttle limiters.

JUNIOR F1 CLASS:

The Junior F1 class rules remain the same. This class has been introduced by CSRA as a transition class to make it safer for **new** Junior racers or Novice class racers to move into the Junior division.

The “Junior F1” class is designated for racers aged (13-17yrs).

Racers must compete with a 0-600cc Fan cooled or 4-Stroke, Stock snowmobile.

Note: Experienced Junior racers that have had a 1st place finish in Junior 1 or Junior 2 will not be permitted to race in this class. Studs are not permitted in this class.

120, NOVICE & JUNIOR F1 - TRACTION PRODUCTS:

Studs are not permitted in any 120, Novice, or the Junior F1 class.

TRAIL SPORT CLASSES:

The CSRA Trail Sport division is designated for first year racers. Trail Sport racers may compete with any 2009 or older snowmobile including the limited build race sleds. Trail Sport racers may also compete with new 2010 full production consumer snowmobiles including the new Arctic Cat Sno Pro 500.

The Yamaha Phazer 4-Stroke and all 0-600cc Fan cooled sleds are also permitted to compete in the 500cc Sport and Trail Sport classes.

SPORT - SEMI-PRO & PRO CLASSES:

The Sport, Semi-Pro and Pro classes remain the same as last year. CSRA will continue to have Open Mod 600cc class racing in both the Semi-Pro and Pro divisions.
